This is a very demanding time schedule. All races will start **EXACTLY** on time.  
You may run as many runners in the J.V. Races & Middle School races as you like.

**Divisions 1-5:**

- Division V – 1 – 250      Division III – 451 – 799      Division I – 1500 and up
- Division IV – 251 – 450      Division II – 800 – 1499

*Our goal is to have 5 equal divisions; we may move you up or down a division, if your school is on the bubble to accommodate our goal.*

- If you enter in the correct email address into our on-line registration system, we will email you a copy of the divisions in a word document by the Wed., Sept. 16<sup>th</sup>. **Place:** Springfield Oaks County Park – 12450 Andersonville Rd. – Davisburg, Michigan 48350

**Entry Fee:** \$99.00 for each team. \$198.00 for a boys and girls team  
\$20.00 per individual (up to 4), for incomplete teams.  
\$99.00 per additional “B” team.

- “B” teams will run in the same division as their varsity team. You must run your 8<sup>th</sup> –14<sup>th</sup> runners as a “B” team.

\$75.00 per middle school “not” accompanied by their varsity program

- Please have the entry fee paid on or before 9/19/09

**Scoring:** Gault Race Management will time our event using “**CHIP**” system, for the varsity races. This is the same system seen at many road races and at the MHSAA State Championships.



**Deadline (1):** Please send in or fax a copy of the CONTRACT and enter in your “projected” top (7) Names and Grades into our on-line registration by Thursday, Sept 11<sup>th</sup>, 2009 at 6:00pm. **You can make changes to this roster over the weekend.**

**Deadline (2):** Entry fees for the meet are due by Saturday, Sept. 19<sup>th</sup>. No payment by this day, will incur a late fee of \$15.00 per team.

**Deadline (3):** You ***must*** have the ***names*** and ***grades*** of your top (7) varsity runners for “**Final Entry**”, in our on-line registration ***by Monday, Sept 14<sup>th</sup> at 6:00pm.*** *It is suggested that you turn off all firewalls and the like for this process, as they have a tendency to interfere with our registration website:*

**Roster Changes:** Now that you met the initial “projected” line up deadline of Thursday (9/11), the registration will close for the weekend. You can use the results of the Friday/Saturday invite you attended to make any changes to your roster from Sunday (9/13) to Monday (9/14) at 6:00pm. Yes, you can make changes on meet day, but up to an hour prior to your race. The less changes on meet day the better. It is out intent to produce timely results for each varsity race. Help us help you.

**Awards:** The top 4 teams in divisions I -V will earn trophies and team medals.  
The top 3 individual finishers in each division & championship series race will earn a plaque & a custom medal w/ ribbon.  
Places 4-35<sup>th</sup> in each divisions I - V will earn a custom medal w/ ribbon.  
The top ten finishers in each division and championship series will earn a “top ten” shirt.  
Each coach of the 1<sup>st</sup> place team, in every division, will earn a winning pen set.  
The top 100 finishers in each J.V. race will earn a ribbon.  
The top 25 finishers in each junior high race will earn a medal.  
The next 75 finishers in each junior high race will earn a ribbon.  
The top 25 male finishers and top 25 female finishers in the open race will earn a medal.

**Final Instructions:** On the day of the meet, coaches are to report the Registration Building where you must get chips for your varsity runners, a course map and final instructions. *You can make changes to your varsity rosters only, up to (1) hour prior to race time.* After that, you will not be allowed to make any changes.

**Park Entry Fee:** Team buses and team vans will be admitted free of charge.  
Everyone else will be charge \$3.00 per person.

**Tee-shirts:** Classy souvenir tee-shirts will again be available in small, medium, large, and extra-large sizes. They will have a different design than last year and will sell for \$15.00.

**Concessions:** The Oakland County 4-H will have a full service concession stand with reasonable prices.

**Results:** Results will be available for each and every varsity race about 30 minutes, after the finish of the particular division race, that you were assigned. ***You can only get a copy of the results, once you return the chips for your team (Just like the State Meet).***

**Chip Fee:** Coaches are ***solely responsible*** for returning the chips for every runner. If you do not return the chips, Gault Racing ***will*** charge you \$7.00 per runner and or \$50.00 per team.
